



The Wheeler Way - Literacy INTENT

Lessons at Wheeler should inspire children/ allow children to develop an enthusiasm for literacy in all its forms and give them the confidence to express themselves both orally and through the written word. Learning should develop reading skills across the content domains and encourage an enjoyment and appreciation of a variety of literature.

The subject pillars are:

Be able to **read** with increasing fluency and comprehension; relative to their stage of development, a wide range of text, with confidence and enjoyment.

Develop the knowledge and be exposed to a wide range of **vocabulary**, which is supported through the explicit teaching of **phonics/ spelling** rules and relationships.

Be able to structure **writing** across a range of genres, whilst being confident in manipulating sentences to suit an intended audience.

To be proud of the literacy learning that is produced and aim to continually improve presentation across all **handwriting** pieces.

Develop **speaking and listening skills** to be able to share opinions, ideas and thoughts whilst demonstrating mutual respect for all.
