Covid Update

As you will be aware the number of positive cases in the area is on the rise and we are seeing more schools having to close bubbles. To help us maintain a safe environment please help us by informing us if you or your child has been in contact with a positive or potential positive case so we can give you the most up to date advice. As always if your child has any of the following symptoms then they must stay at home to isolate for a minimum of 10 days or seek a test:

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- **a high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

In addition please ensure you are adhering to social distancing in and around the school site and stay 2 metres away from anyone who is not in your household.
