

Wheeler Primary School - Topic Planning FS2 - Autumn 1

SPARKS – Feelings Dress up day, visits from PCSO and Dentists

As Communicators we will develop our conversational skills by learning how to take it in turns to speak, and to respond to questions.

We will be developing our vocabulary by learning new words and exploring the meaning of them.

We will be using story language and retelling stories. We will listen to and learn nursery rhymes, and we will use non-fiction books to help us develop our knowledge and understanding of the world around us.

In PSED we will be exploring the topic 'Me in My World'.

We will be developing our understanding of our feelings. We will give names to different feelings and we will explore how our feelings can affect us and how we can manage them.

We will learn about how we need to be in our classroom and we will develop an understanding of our rights and responsibilities

As Readers and Writers we will be linking our literacy with our topic and exploring books relating to our experiences. Our key texts will be 'The Colour Monster' and 'Owl Babies'.

We will be focussing on the Phase 2 element of phonics, looking at recognising the sounds made by the letters of the alphabet, and developing our oral blending and segmenting skills. We will have plenty of opportunities to make marks and write independently.

Fabulous Feelings

As Mathematicians we will be developing our understanding of what numbers are. We will learn to read, count and order numbers to 1,2 and 3.

We will be exploring the concepts of more and less, and the same and different. We will learn to add and subtract using practical apparatus.

We will be exploring patterns and shapes.

We will be exploring how we use Maths in the world around us.

In developing our Understanding of the World we will be learning about the different jobs of people who help us such as: doctors, nurses, builders etc. We will be learning about the importance of developing our own skills e.g. trying hard, never giving up, being brave, being kind and how we can develop our own skills. We will be learning about how we can stay fit and healthy, and how we need to look after ourselves.

As part of our Physical Development we will be developing our fine motor skills and learning how to write our name.

We are also developing our gross motor skills through a wide range of physical activities, both inside and outside.

Through Expressive Arts and Design we will be exploring a wide variety of media and materials. We will work independently to make our own creations, and we will follow instructions to develop specific skills.

We will be developing our imaginative play by engaging in role play and small world play. We will be singing familiar songs and learning new ones.
