PE Days are Thursdays this term we will be doing cricket and athletics.

As Scientists we will:

As Scientists this term we will learn about the different life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird and compare the similarities and differences of these. We will learn about the human body and changes that occur as humans develop from birth to old age. We will also learn about the life process of animals including reproduction using MRG NERG. As part of this we will learn about the gestation periods of different animals .

As Geographers we will: This term we will use our map reading skills, focusing on grid references and lines of latitude and longitude, to locate Greece and its major cities and landmarks, and then consider its position in relation to the UK. We will then look at the human features of Ancient Athens, how

As Artists and Designers we will:

As Artists we will take inspiration from the great architecture of Ancient Greece and consider how it has inspired modern-day designs. We will continue to refine our printing skills by creating relief printing blocks that we then use to create ink prints of more than one colour.

As Authors and Readers we will:

Explore Who Let The Gods Out by Maz Evans looking at the archaic vocabulary and features. We will write our own historical narratives and use our history knowledge to make our stories even more interesting!

As Historians we will:

As Historians we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We will use sources of evidence to understand what life was like during these times with a focus on food, society, beliefs, and housing. We will learn about all of the significant achievements of the Greeks and how that has shaped the world we live in today.

As Musicians we will:

We will listen to Fresh Prince of Belair, Make you feel my love. We will use this song to help our understanding of different genres of music, finding the pulse of a song, and how different songs are made up. We will then sing and use glockenspiels to perform the song.
