As Mathematicians we will:

As Historians we will:

Study the Stone Age and its key events and developments. We will look at everyday life and use a range of evidence to make deductions about the past. We will visit the Hull and East riding museum.

As Musicians we will:

Learn the song, "Three Little Birds" to explore the dimensions of music. We will begin to learn the duration of a wider range of notes and use them to play instruments.

In Religion and Worldviews we will:

Look at the Christian faith and Easter. This will give us more of an understanding of different beliefs and celebrations.
